ARB staff is developing amendments designed to address issues raised by industry litigation, and to take into account current conditions and trends in zero and near-zero emissions technology development. The broad topics under consideration include removal of all references to fuel economy, modification of the 15 year-150,000 mile PZEV warranty required for hybrid electric vehicles, and modification of the compliance requirements and options in response to the current state of ZEV technology.
