Sweden Bars Computers On Way to Soviet

STOCKHOLM, Dec. 21 (UPI) — Sweden barred a shipment of 30 tons of American-made computer components from being sent to the Soviet Union today, classifying the cargo as “war material.”

The Government said the shipment would leave Sweden only if its manufacturer, the Digital Equipment Corporation, of Maynard, Mass., requested its return.

Four containers holding the computer equipment have been kept under police guard in the southern port of Helsingborg since they were impounded a month ago.
