I would like to propose a new variation to the current Sears/Donnelly contract regarding the compatibility issue.

We will guarantee that DR DOS will be compatible with any current or future version of Windows that runs on MS DOS 3.x, since MS DOS 3.x is the industry baseline that is used for application compatibility.

We would also need to limit our liability to \$9.50 per user if a DOS replacement was required for Sears installed customer base.

If you think that Sears would agree to these terms, I can put this concept into legal language for your review.
